

What to bring with you?

Lodging will be in a gym, so bring:

- a **sleeping bag** and a **sleeping mattress**;
- **slippers** or some other appropriate shoes for walking inside a gym;
- in case you are bringing an inflatable mattress, we can lend you the **pump**.

You should also bring:

- all **toilet requisites** you need or you think you'll need (however there are well supplied shops everywhere in case you forget something or you don't want to carry, but because of holidays they won't be open all the time);
- any kind of **medication** you might need (special attention: if you have some allergy)

Besides regular clothing that you wear during the day or during the night=), don't forget:

- **bathing suit** and **towel** – we will spend one day in pool&sauna;
- one red T-shirt for Red Love Party
- one white T-shirt for Grafitti Party (at the end of the evening it will not be white anymore, so bring one you won't need anymore)

-Bring **warm clothes and shoes!** Weather in these days is quite unpredictable: last week it was -10° with a lot of snow, today we have 5° and sun. Weather forecast for next week says that it will again get colder, so be prepared on everything.):!

Documents:

- **Identity card or Passport**;
- **Student ID** card if you have one;
- Optional: **travel insurance documentation** or **health insurance card**. Citizens of EU member states can get free health insurance card – check: <http://ec.europa.eu/social/main.jsp?catId=559&langId=en> (choose your country in top right corner). It is valid in Slovenia. I advise you check with your Ministry of Health what is applicable for you.

European Night:

Traditional drinks and food from your country (attention: you won't have a chance to cook it, so you can bring some traditional sweets or something that can last for few days) for the European Night. You can also bring some other things to represent your country (flag, leaflets, maps etc).

Present/gift:

We are going to organize a small distribution of gifts, so please bring **a small present from your country** (its value mustn't exceed 3 euros!). The best option is that you use your imagination and creativity and make something on your own!

Finances:

The organizers are providing you with **two meals per day** (usually breakfast and supper, but sometimes lunch) and the fee also covers all the **expenses for the programme** and the **transfer within the event**.

So, you will need some money for some additional food, drinks when going out and if you like some souvenirs or any other item you would like to buy.

Prices in Slovenia: you can get kebabs for around 3€, big pizzas for 7-8€, coffee for 1,3-1,5€, coke for 1,5-2€, a beer (half a liter) for around 2,3€, a cocktail for 4-6€, a glass of wine for 1-2€.

Credit and debit cards are widely used and you can also withdraw money.

IMPORTANT: For the New Year we are organizing a party in a really nice club! As you know, prices during holidays can get much higher, that's why we have arranged at the bar special prices of drinks for you! But in order to organize that **we will ask each of you at the registration (when you come to the gym) for special consumption of 8€.** For these 8€ you will get coupons before the NY party, which you will change in the club for the drinks. So, for these 8€ you will get drinks that you will choose!

Currency:

In Slovenia the currency is Euro (€).
